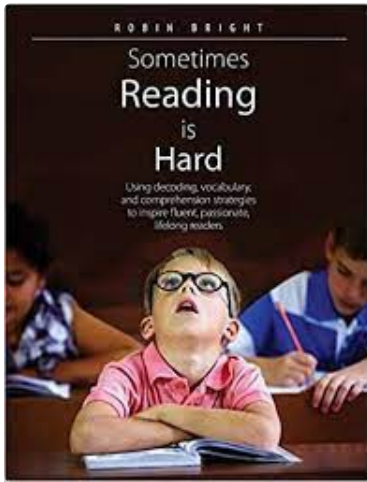

We are all teachers of reading!

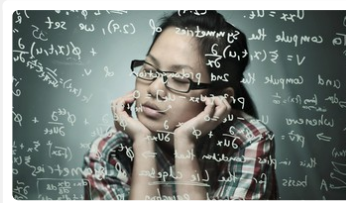
