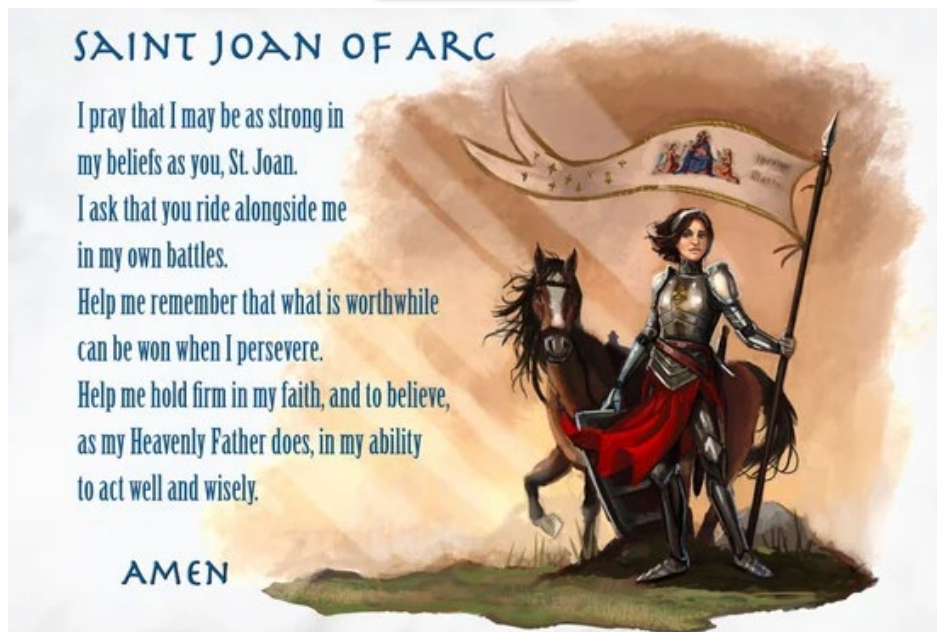

- Reflected the Mission Statement of the Holy Spirit School Division in all actions:

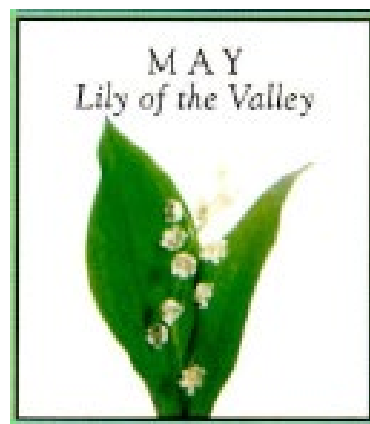
